20 lieu thereof the following:

22 “(5) For the 2010-11 school year, the amount of state aid shall be [seventy-two] fifty-eight
23 percent of the amount of state aid calculated for the district for the 2010-11 school year under the
24 provisions of subsection 1 of this section plus [twenty-eight] forty-two percent of the total amount
25 of state revenue received by the district for the 2005-06 school year from the foundation formula,
26 line 14, gifted, remedial reading, exceptional pupil aid, fair share, and free textbook payments less
27 any amounts received under section 163.043.

28 (6) For the 2011-12 school year, the amount of state aid shall be [eighty-six] fifty-eight
29 percent of the amount of state aid calculated for the district for the 2011-12 school year under the
30 provisions of subsection 1 of this section plus [fourteen] forty-two percent of the total amount of
31 state revenue received by the district for the 2005-06 school year from the foundation formula,
32 line 14, gifted, remedial reading, exceptional pupil aid, fair share, and free textbook payments less
33 any amounts received under section 163.043.

1 (7) For the 2012-13 school year, the amount of state aid shall be sixty percent of the
2 amount of state aid calculated for the district for the 2012-13 school year under the provisions of
3 subsection 1 of this section plus forty percent of the total amount of state revenue received by the
4 district for the 2005-06 school year from the foundation formula, line 14, gifted, remedial reading,
5 exceptional pupil aid, fair share, and free textbook payments less any amounts received under
6 section 163.043.

7 (8) For the 2013-14 school year, the amount of state aid shall be seventy percent of the
8 amount of state aid calculated for the district for the 2013-14 school year under the provisions of
9 subsection 1 of this section plus thirty percent of the total amount of state revenue received by the
10 district for the 2005-06 school year from the foundation formula, line 14, gifted, remedial reading,
11 exceptional pupil aid, fair share, and free textbook payments less any amounts received under
12 section 163.043.

13 (9) For the 2014-15 school year, the amount of state aid shall be eighty percent of the
14 amount of state aid calculated for the district for the 2014-15 school year under the provisions of
15 subsection 1 of this section plus twenty percent of the total amount of state revenue received by
16 the district for the 2005-06 school year from the foundation formula, line 14, gifted, remedial
17 reading, exceptional pupil aid, fair share, and free textbook payments less any amounts received
18 under section 163.043.

19 (10) For the 2015-16 school year, the amount of state aid shall be ninety percent of the
20 amount of state aid calculated for the district for the 2015-16 school year under the provisions of
21 subsection 1 of this section plus ten percent of the total amount of state revenue received by the
22 district for the 2005-06 school year from the foundation formula, line 14, gifted, remedial reading,
23 exceptional pupil aid, fair share, and free textbook payments less any amounts received under
24 section 163.043.

25 (11) For the 2016-17 school year and subsequent years, the amount of state aid shall be as
26 calculated under subsection 1 of this section.

27 (12) The provisions of this subsection shall not prohibit the General Assembly from
28 appropriating more funds than required to fund the applicable percentages provided for in any
29 school year under this subsection. In such an instance, the department of elementary and
30 secondary education shall adjust such phase-in percentages in order to accommodate the total
31 amount of available appropriations so that such percentages equal one hundred percent and the
32 total amount of the appropriated funds is distributed.

33 (13) For any school year governed by this subsection, if the foundation formula
34 appropriation under subsections 1, 2, and 4 of this section is equal to or greater than the fiscal year
35 2010 foundation formula expenditure under subsections 1, 2, and 4 of this section and the
36 previous fiscal year's foundation formula expenditures under subsections 1, 2, and 4 of this
37 section but is insufficient to fully fund the applicable percentages provided for in any school year
38 under this subsection or the current year appropriation is reduced by the governor as provided in
39 Section 27 of Article IV of the Missouri Constitution and as a result of said reduction the reduced

1 appropriation is insufficient to fully fund the applicable percentages provided for in any school
2 year under this subsection, the department of elementary and secondary education shall reduce the
3 payment amounts awarded to all districts, including those districts that qualify under subsection 2
4 of this section. The department of elementary and secondary education shall calculate a uniform
5 proportional reduction percentage based on all available foundation formula state aid for the given
6 school year to be applied to the payment amount to which all districts would otherwise be entitled
7 under the applicable phase-in percentage for the applicable school year as provided in this
8 subsection.

9 (14) In any school year governed by this subsection in which the foundation formula
10 appropriation under subsections 1, 2, and 4 of this section is less than the fiscal year 2010
11 foundation formula expenditure under subsections 1, 2, and 4 of this section; less than the
12 previous fiscal year’s foundation formula expenditure under subsections 1, 2, and 4 of this
13 section; or reduced from the current year appropriation by the governor as provided in Section 27
14 of Article IV of the Missouri Constitution and as a result of said reduction the reduced
15 appropriation is less than the foundation formula fiscal year 2010 expenditure or less than the
16 previous fiscal year’s foundation formula expenditure, the department of elementary and
17 secondary education shall reduce the payment amounts awarded to all districts, including those
18 districts that qualify under subsection 2 of this section. The department shall calculate a uniform
19 proportional reduction percentage based on all available foundation formula state aid for the given
20 school year to be applied to the payment amount to which all districts would otherwise be entitled
21 under the applicable phase-in percentage for the applicable school year as provided in this
22 subsection.

23 (15) (a) Notwithstanding subdivision (18) of section 163.011, the state adequacy target” ;

29 Further amend said bill and section, Page 5, Line 139, by placing a closing bracket “]”
30 immediately after “(c)” ; and

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32 Further amend said bill, Page 6, Section B, Line 5, by inserting immediately after the word
33 “approval” the following:

34 “or July 1, 2010, whichever occurs later.” ; and

35 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
36 accordingly.
