Bill Summary: The proposal adds citizenship information to the sexual offender registration form and requires the State Highway Patrol to report to the federal government any non-US citizen on the sexual offender registry and modifies provisions relating to required participation in a federal work authorization program.

**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of Administration – Administrative Hearing Commission, Department of Transportation, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Public Safety – Director’s Office,** and the **Department of Conservation** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed within existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety – Missouri State Highway Patrol’s (MSHP) Information Systems Division** state that to develop an automated solution for identifying individuals that are not United States citizens and are listed on the Sexual Offender Registry, a programming effort would be required. Development costs are estimated to be 290 hours which includes identifying the citizenship on the Sexual Offender Registry website (SOR WEBSITE). The current contract rate is \$82 per hour for a total cost of \$23,780 (290 hours x \$82/hour). Yearly maintenance costs cannot be estimated at this point but would be billed at the \$82 per hour rate. However, it is expected that routine maintenance would be minimal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation adds national citizenship to the information that must be included on a sexual offender registration form and requires the State Highway Patrol to report to the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement or other appropriate federal agency certain information regarding any person on the sexual offender registry who is not a citizen of the United States.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program, and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
