AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a special license plate for Vietnam era military veterans.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 301.3149, to read as follows:

301.3149. Any person who served in any branch of the United States armed forces
2 during the Vietnam Conflict may apply for special motor vehicle license plates for any
3 vehicle he or she owns, either solely or jointly, other than commercial vehicles weighing
4 over twelve thousand pounds. Any such person shall make application for the special
5 license plates on a form provided by the director of revenue and furnish such proof of
6 service in the armed forces during the Vietnam Conflict as the director may require. The
7 director shall then issue license plates bearing letters or numbers or a combination thereof
8 as determined by the advisory committee established in section 301.129, with the words
9 "VIETNAM ERA MILITARY VETERAN" in place of the words "SHOW-ME STATE".
10 Such license plates shall be made with fully reflective material with a common color scheme
11 and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as
12 prescribed by section 301.130. There shall be no fee in addition to regular registration fees
13 for the initial set of plates issued to the applicant, however, there shall be an additional fee
14 charged for each subsequent set of special license plates issued equal to the fee charged for
15 personalized license plates, but the additional fee shall only have to be paid once by the
16 qualified applicant at the time of initial application for the additional set of plates. There
17 shall be no limit on the number of license plates any person qualified under this section

18 may obtain so long as each set of license plates issued under this section is issued for
19 vehicles owned solely or jointly by such person. License plates issued under this section
20 shall not be transferable to any other person except that any registered co-owner of the
21 motor vehicle may operate the motor vehicle for the duration of the year licensed in the
22 event of the death of the qualified person.

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
