## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 407, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to deceptive advertising practices.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 407, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 407.311, to read as follows:

- 407.311. 1. No person or business shall misrepresent the geographic location of the supplier of a service or product by listing, displaying, or publishing a fictitious business name or an assumed business name in a telephone directory or any advertisement, including but not limited to, any written, television, or radio advertisement or any flyer if:
  - (1) The name misrepresents the geographic location of the supplier; and
- (2) The listing or advertisement fails to identify the address including the state of the business of the supplier.
- 2. For purposes of this section, a person or business who lists, displays, or publishes advertisements or a telephone company or other provider of a telephone directory or its officer or agent is immune from liability for listing, displaying, or publishing a fictitious business name or assumed business name of a supplier unless such person, business, or telephone company or other provider of a telephone directory is the same person as the supplier of the services or products who has committed the deceptive act.
- 3. Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of an unlawful practice under section 407.020.
