1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 121, Section 51.050, Page 1, Line 5 by  
2 inserting after all of said Section, Page, and Line the following:

3 "115.043. Each election authority may make all rules and regulations, not inconsistent  
4 with statutory provisions, necessary for the registration of voters and the conduct of elections.  
5 Such rules and regulations may include a procedure by which an election authority may provide  
6 each registered voter residing within the election authority's jurisdiction the option of providing  
7 the voter's email address to the election authority to use for providing information to voters in  
8 conjunction with the conduct of elections. Providing information to a voter's email address by an  
9 election authority shall not be construed to fulfill the election authority's responsibility to provide  
10 notice or other election communications to any voter as required by state law.

11 115.155. 1. The election authority shall provide for the registration of each voter. Each  
12 application shall be in substantially the following form: APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION

23 I am a citizen of the United States and a resident of the state of Missouri. I have not been  
 24 adjudged incapacitated by any court of law. If I have been convicted of a felony or of a  
 25 misdemeanor connected with the right of suffrage, I have had the voting disabilities resulting from  
 26 such conviction removed pursuant to law. I do solemnly swear that all statements made on this  
 27 card are true to the best of my knowledge and belief. I UNDERSTAND THAT IF I REGISTER  
 28 TO VOTE KNOWING THAT I AM NOT LEGALLY ENTITLED TO REGISTER, I AM  
 29 COMMITTING A CLASS ONE ELECTION OFFENSE AND MAY BE PUNISHED BY  
 30 IMPRISONMENT OF NOT MORE THAN FIVE YEARS OR BY A FINE OF BETWEEN TWO  
 31 THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS OR BY BOTH  
 32 SUCH IMPRISONMENT AND FINE. .... Signature of

35 2. After supplying all information necessary for the registration records, each applicant  
 36 who appears in person before the election authority shall swear or affirm the statements on the

1 registration application by signing his or her full name, witnessed by the signature of the election  
2 authority or such authority's deputy registration official. Each applicant who applies to register by  
3 mail pursuant to section 115.159, or pursuant to section 115.160 or 115.162, shall attest to the  
4 statements on the application by his or her signature.

5 3. Upon receipt by mail of a completed and signed voter registration application, a voter  
6 registration application forwarded by the division of motor vehicle and drivers licensing of the  
7 department of revenue pursuant to section 115.160, or a voter registration agency pursuant to  
8 section 115.162, the election authority shall, if satisfied that the applicant is entitled to register,  
9 transfer all data necessary for the registration records from the application to its registration  
10 system. Within seven business days after receiving the application, the election authority shall  
11 send the applicant a verification notice. If such notice is returned as undeliverable by the postal  
12 service within the time established by the election authority, the election authority shall not place  
13 the applicant's name on the voter registration file.

14 4. If, upon receipt by mail of a voter registration application or a voter registration  
15 application forwarded pursuant to section 115.160 or 115.162, the election authority determines  
16 that the applicant is not entitled to register, such authority shall, within seven business days after  
17 receiving the application, so notify the applicant by mail and state the reason such authority has  
18 determined the applicant is not qualified. The applicant may have such determination reviewed  
19 pursuant to the provisions of section 115.223. If an applicant for voter registration fails to answer  
20 the question on the application concerning United States citizenship, the election authority shall  
21 notify the applicant of the failure and provide the applicant with an opportunity to complete the  
22 form in a timely manner to allow for the completion of the registration form before the next  
23 election.

24 5. It shall be the responsibility of the secretary of state to prescribe specifications for voter  
25 registration documents so that they are uniform throughout the state of Missouri and comply with  
26 the National Voter Registration Act of 1993, including the reporting requirements, and so that  
27 registrations, name changes and transfers of registrations within the state may take place as  
28 allowed by law.

29 6. All voter registration applications shall be preserved in the office of the election  
30 authority.

31 7. Each election authority may provide each applicant for voter registration with the  
32 option of providing the applicant's email address with the applicant's voter registration form.”; and
