1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 213, Page 1, Section 188.015, Lines 5 - 9  
2 by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 “(a) the act of using or prescribing any instrument, device, medicine, drug, or any other means  
4 or substance with the intent to destroy the life of an embryo or fetus in his or her mother's womb; or

5 (b) the intentional termination of the pregnancy of a mother by using or prescribing any  
6 instrument, device, medicine, drug, or any other means or substance with an intention other than to  
7 increase the probability of a live birth or to remove a dead or dying unborn child.”; and

8  
9 Further amend said Bill, Section 118.030, Page 3, Line 31 by deleting all of said line and inserting in  
10 lieu thereof the following:

11 “2. Except in the case of a medical emergency:

12 (1) Prior to performing or inducing”; and

13  
14 Further amend said Bill, Section 118.030, Page 3, Line 55 - 56 by deleting all of said lines and  
15 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16 “(4) (a) If the physician determines that the unborn child is viable, the physician”; and

18 Further amend said Bill and Section, Page 5, Lines 108 - 116 by deleting all of said lines and inserting  
19 in lieu thereof the following:

20 “4. Any physician who pleads guilty to or is found guilty of performing or inducing an  
21 abortion of an unborn child in violation of this section shall be subject to suspension or revocation of  
22 his or her license to practice medicine in the state of Missouri by the State Board of Registration for  
23 the Healing Arts pursuant to the provisions of sections 334.100 and 334.103.

24 5. Any hospital licensed in the state of Missouri that knowingly allows an abortion of an  
25 unborn child to be performed or induced in violation of this section may be subject to suspension or  
26 revocation of its license under the provisions of section 197.070.

27 6. Any ambulatory surgical center licensed in the state of Missouri that knowingly allows an  
28 abortion of an unborn child to be performed or induced in violation of this section may be subject to  
29 suspension or revocation of its license under the provisions of section 197.220.”; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
32 accordingly.
