1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 732, Section 334.001, Page 9, Lines 26-
2 31, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 “4. At its discretion, the board may disclose confidential information, without the consent
4 of the licensee or applicant, to a licensee or applicant for a license in order to further a board
5 investigation or to facilitate settlement negotiations with the board, in the course of voluntary
6 exchange of information with another state’s physician licensing authority, pursuant to a court
7 order, or to other administrative or law enforcement agencies acting within the scope of their
8 statutory authority.”; and

10 Further amend said bill, Section 334.100, Page 14, Line 32, by deleting the words, “or any
11 municipal violation”; and

13 Further amend said bill, Section 621.110, Page 37, Line 22, by inserting after all of said section
14 and line the following:

15 “Section 1. The state board of registration for the healing arts, in consultation with the
16 state board of cosmetology and barber examiners, shall promulgate rules that:

17 (1) Require the direct, on-site supervision by a licensed physician for the use of lasers and
18 pulse light sources classified as Class III-B and/or Class IV lasers by the Food and Drug
19 Administration; and

20 (2) Require the indirect supervision by a licensed physician for the use of lasers and pulse
21 light sources classified as Class I, II, and III-A lasers by the Food and Drug Administration; and

22 (3) Require an informed consent document be signed by the patient clearly stating the
23 diagnosis, risks, and benefits of laser therapy; and

24 (4) Require the patient be provided with the name, qualifications, and licensure, if
25 applicable, of the person or persons administering the treatment and the directions for contacting
26 personnel for potential complications and follow-up care.”; and

28 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
29 accordingly.
