ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Agriculture** and **University of Missouri** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposed legislation

Officials at the **Office of the Attorney General (AGO)** assumes that any potential costs relating to implementation of the proposal could be absorbed with existing resources. Since the proposal could be the subject of litigation, the AGO assumes that costs are unknown. If significant cases result over time, the AGO would seek an additional appropriation in the future.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
