

HB 853 -- Community Center Sales Tax in the City of Excelsior Springs

This bill authorizes the City of Excelsior Springs to impose, upon voter approval, a retail sales tax of up to 1% for the purpose of funding the construction, maintenance, operation, and equipping of a community center and for retiring any bonds issued for that purpose. The Department of Revenue will deposit the sales tax collected in the newly created City Community Center Sales Tax Trust Fund less 1% of the amount collected which is to be deposited into the General Revenue Fund for the cost of collection.
