

HJR 34 -- General Assembly Term Limits

Sponsor: Nasheed

Upon voter approval, this proposed constitutional amendment prohibits anyone elected to the General Assembly after November 1, 2008, from serving more than 12 years in any one house nor more than 24 years total in both houses. The current term limit of eight years in each house of the General Assembly is retained for those elected prior to November 1, 2008.

Service of less than one year for a member of the House of Representatives or two years for a member of the Senate by a person elected at any time to complete the term of office of another person will not be counted for purposes of the term limitations.
