HB 1134 -- Insurance Coverage for Physical Therapy Services

Sponsor: Scharnhorst

This bill prohibits a health insurer from imposing a greater copayment, coinsurance, or deductible to an insured for covered services provided by a licensed physical therapist than that charged for the same covered services provided by a licensed primary care physician or an osteopath. A health insurer must clearly state the availability of physical therapy coverage under its plan and all related limitations, conditions, and exclusions.
