

HCS HB 1186 & 1147 -- ENGLISH ONLY DRIVER'S LICENSE EXAMINATIONS
(Parkinson)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Committee on International Trade and Job
Creation

This substitute requires Missouri driver's license examinations to only be administered in English so that the applicant can demonstrate his or her ability to sufficiently understand highway traffic signs and safety warnings. The Director of the Department of Revenue cannot supply or permit the use of language interpreters, except sign language interpreters, in connection with the required written and driving tests.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on General Revenue Fund in FY 2013, FY 2014, and FY 2015. Estimated Net Income on Other State Funds of \$52,580 in FY 2013, \$0 in FY 2014, and \$0 in FY 2015.
