HB 1229 -- Recording Certain Higher Education Lectures

Sponsor: Curtman

This bill specifies that a student at any higher education institution in the state that is funded in whole or part by state appropriations has the right to record public classroom lectures for his or her use. The provisions of the bill cannot be interpreted to permit the dissemination of the recordings for compensation and does not waive or infringe any institutional policy on copyright or intellectual property interests that are eligible for state or federal protection.
