HB 1302 -- Capital Green Program

Sponsor: Holsman

This bill establishes the Capital Green Program to provide funding for weatherization and energy efficiency improvements to the State Capitol Building and the Governor's Mansion and for geothermal, wind, and solar energy resources and to install a network of environmentally friendly free-flow turbine generators in the Missouri River to provide power to the State Capitol Building and the Governor's Mansion. If surplus energy is generated, it may also be used to provide power to the Harry S Truman Office Building, Missouri Supreme Court Building, and James C. Kirkpatrick State Information Center. The Capital Green Program Fund is created which will consist of appropriations from the General Assembly, gifts, bequests, and donations to be used solely for the administration of the program.

The provisions of the bill will expire six years after the effective date.
