HB 1365 -- Candidate Qualifications

Sponsor: Lasater

This bill specifies that the provisions which prohibit a person from qualifying as a candidate for elective public office if he or she has been convicted of, found guilty of, or pled guilty to a felony will apply to any person seeking to qualify as a candidate for an elected office in cities of the fourth classification. Currently, fourth class cities are exempt from the definition of "elective public office" in Section 115.013(22), RSMo.
