

HB 1419 -- Text Messaging While Driving

Sponsor: Colona

Currently, individuals 21 years of age or younger are prohibited from sending, reading, or writing a text message or electronic message from a hand-held electronic wireless communications device while operating a moving motor vehicle on any highway in this state. This bill prohibits anyone, regardless of age, from these activities but specifies that no person can be stopped, inspected, or detained solely to determine compliance with this provision.
