

HB 1551 -- Operating a Motorized Vessel with Excessive Blood  
Alcohol Content

Sponsor: Cookson

This bill creates the crime of operating a motorized vessel with excessive blood alcohol content when a person operates a motorized vessel on any navigable river or waterway of the state with a blood alcohol content (BAC) of .08 or 1% or more. Anyone committing the crime will be guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
