HB 1587 -- University of Missouri Board of Curators

This bill requires that one voting member of the University of Missouri Board of Curators be a student. The student will have the right to vote on any issue, including the hiring or firing of the president of the University of Missouri system and other general officers of the university but may not participate in other personnel decisions concerning the hiring or firing of faculty or staff. The first voting student curator must be appointed in January 2013 and must be a graduate or professional student, who will replace the current nonvoting student representative. The bill also revises the procedure for student representation if the university adds more campuses.
