

HB 1595 -- Advisory Council on the Education of Gifted and Talented Children

Sponsor: Lampe

This bill establishes the seven-member Advisory Council on the Education of Gifted and Talented Children, appointed by the Commissioner of Education within the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education to serve four-year terms. The State Board of Education must consider recommendations for membership on the council from organizations and parents with an interest in the education of gifted and talented children. Members will be selected based on their knowledge of or experience in this subject. The commissioner must seek the advice of the council on all rules and policies relating to the subject. The department must provide a staff person and necessary clerical support.
