

HB 1626 -- Urban School District Elections

Sponsor: Sommer

This bill specifies that any school district that becomes an urban school district as a result of the 2010 census or any subsequent census will continue to hold elections on its current schedule. A school district is classified as an urban district when it encompasses at least half of the area or population of a city of 70,000 or more inhabitants.

The bill contains an emergency clause.
