

HB 1630 -- Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission

This bill specifies that only one person can be appointed to the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission from the same Congressional district and that an appointee must be a citizen of the United States. In the event a member of the commission is found, by a unanimous vote of the other commissioners, to have moved out of the district from which he or she was appointed, his or her office will be forfeited and considered vacant. A commissioner may complete his or her term if the composition or configuration of his or her Congressional district changes during his or her term.
