HB 1658 -- Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility

Currently, a person who fails to maintain his or her required financial motor vehicle responsibility is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$300 for a first violation and punishable by imprisonment for a term of up to 15 days, a fine of up to \$300, or both for a second or subsequent violation. This bill changes the punishment to a fine of \$300 for a first violation and imprisonment for a term of up to 15 days and a fine of \$500 for a second or subsequent violation.
