AN ACT

To amend chapter 262, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to rodeos.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 262, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 262.750, to read as follows:

2 **262.750. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the right to conduct and**
3 **participate in rodeos in this state shall be guaranteed and no law, ordinance, or rule shall**
4 **be enacted to prohibit the conducting of or participation in rodeos in this state; except that,**
5 **nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting any reasonable restrictions**
6 **regarding time, place, and manner consistent with other similar events. Promoters of**
7 **rodeos shall have the authority to establish fees and set rules for their specific events,**
8 **including but not limited to qualifications and procedures for participation.**
