

HB 865 -- Removal of Deceased Voters from Registration Records

This bill requires the Department of Health and Senior Services to establish a notification system that requires all certificates of death filed and registered by local registrars to be reported, by county, to the appropriate election authorities in order to permit the election authorities to remove the names of the deceased voters from its registration records. Each local registrar must report to the department the names, ages, and known voting addresses in the county of all persons for whom a certificate of death has been filed and registered with the registrar. Each election authority must remove the name of any voter reported dead under these provisions from the voter registration records within 30 days of the death of the voter.
