

SB 58 -- PASSAGE OF ORDINANCES IN THE CITY OF FARMINGTON

SPONSOR: Romine

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Committee on Local Government by a vote of 20 to 0.

This bill authorizes the city council of the City of Farmington to also adopt or repeal any ordinance by submitting the proposed ordinance to the registered voters of the city at the next municipal election.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that in the City of Farmington, there is a big controversy over whether to enact an ordinance banning smoking in public places. The fairest way to answer this question is to let the people of Farmington decide.

Testifying for the bill was Senator Romine.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
