1 AMEND House Bill No. 1320, Page 1, in the Title, line 3, by deleting all of said line and inserting
2 in lieu thereof the following:

4 "breast-feeding."; and

6 Further amend said bill and page, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and line the
7 following:

9 "191.918. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a mother may, with
10 [as much] discretion [as possible], breast-feed her child or express breast milk in any public or
11 private location where the mother is otherwise authorized to be.

12 2. The act of a mother breast-feeding a child or expressing breast milk in a public or private
13 location where the mother and child are otherwise authorized to be shall not:

14 (1) Constitute sexual conduct or sexual contact as defined in section 566.010; or

15 (2) Be considered an act of public indecency, indecent exposure, sexual conduct, lewd
16 touching, or obscenity or any other similar term for purposes of state or municipal law.

17 3. A municipality shall not enact an ordinance prohibiting or restricting a mother from
18 breast-feeding a child or expressing breast milk in a public or private location where the mother and
19 child are otherwise authorized to be."; and

21 Further amend said bill and page, Section 494.430, line 4, by inserting after all of said line the
22 following:

24 "(2) Any nursing mother, upon her request, and with a completed written statement from her
25 physician to the court certifying she is a nursing mother;"; and

27 Renumber remaining subsections accordingly; and

29 Further amend said bill and section, Page 1, Line 16 to Page 2, Line 17, by deleting all of said lines
30 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

32 "may be provided by the employee's religious supervisor."; and

34 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
35 accordingly.
