1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1823, Page 1, In the Title , Line 3, by
2 deleting the words "virtual schools" and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
3 "elementary and secondary education"; and

5 Further amend said bill and page, Section A, Line 2, by adding after all of said line the following:

6 "162.481. 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, all elections of school directors in
7 urban districts shall be held biennially at the same times and places as municipal elections.

8 2. In any urban district which includes all or the major part of a city which first obtained a
9 population of more than seventy-five thousand inhabitants by reason of the 1960 federal decennial
10 census, elections of directors shall be held on municipal election days of even-numbered years. The
11 directors of the prior district shall continue as directors of the urban district until their successors are
12 elected as herein provided. On the first Tuesday in April, 1964, four directors shall be elected, two
13 for terms of two years to succeed the two directors of the prior district who were elected in 1960 and
14 two for terms of six years to succeed the two directors of the prior district who were elected in 1961.
15 The successors of these directors shall be elected for terms of six years. On the first Tuesday in
16 April, 1968, two directors shall be elected for terms to commence on November 5, 1968, and to
17 terminate on the first Tuesday in April, 1974, when their successors shall be elected for terms of six
18 years. No director shall serve more than two consecutive six-year terms after October 13, 1963.

19 3. Except as otherwise provided in subsections 4 [and] , 5, 6, and 7 of this section, hereafter
20 when a seven-director district becomes an urban district, the directors of the prior seven-director
21 district shall continue as directors of the urban district until the expiration of the terms for which they
22 were elected and until their successors are elected as provided in this subsection. The first biennial
23 school election for directors shall be held in the urban district at the time provided in subsection 1
24 which is on the date of or subsequent to the expiration of the terms of the directors of the prior
25 district which are first to expire, and directors shall be elected to succeed the directors of the prior
26 district whose terms have expired. If the terms of two directors only have expired, the directors
27 elected at the first biennial school election in the urban district shall be elected for terms of six years.
28 If the terms of four directors have expired, two directors shall be elected for terms of six years and
29 two shall be elected for terms of four years. At the next succeeding biennial election held in the
30 urban district, successors for the remaining directors of the prior seven-director district shall be
31 elected. If only two directors are to be elected they shall be elected for terms of six years each. If
32 four directors are to be elected, two shall be elected for terms of six years and two shall be elected
33 for terms of two years. After seven directors of the urban district have been elected under this
34 subsection, their successors shall be elected for terms of six years.

35 4. In any school district in any city with a population of one hundred thousand or more
36 inhabitants which is located within a county of the first classification that adjoins no other county of

1 the first classification, or any school district which becomes an urban school district by reason of the
2 2000 federal decennial census, elections shall be held annually at the same times and places as
3 general municipal elections for all years where one or more terms expire, and the terms shall be for
4 three years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified for all directors elected on and
5 after August 28, 1998.

6 5. In any school district in any county with a charter form of government and with more than
7 three hundred thousand but fewer than four hundred fifty thousand inhabitants which becomes an
8 urban school district by reason of the 2010 federal decennial census, elections shall be held annually
9 at the same times and places as general municipal elections for all years where one or more terms
10 expire, and the terms shall be for three years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified
11 for all directors elected on and after April 2, 2012.

12 6. In any school district in a county of any classification where the term of office for
13 directors is set at three years, which becomes an urban school district by reason of any federal
14 decennial census, the school board of such county may by majority vote, at any time twelve or more
15 weeks prior to an election where one or more seats expire, vote to continue elections for three year
16 terms in office for directors. Elections shall be held annually at the same times and places as general
17 municipal elections for all years where one or more terms expire, and the terms shall be for three
18 years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

19 7. If a school district of any classification has changed at any time to an urban school district
20 by reason of any federal decennial census and such district has followed the procedures of subsection
21 4 of this section through an entire election cycle such that all seven directors of such district
22 currently serve six year terms in office with biennial elections, then the directors may by majority
23 vote, conducted at least twelve weeks prior to any election where one or more director terms in
24 office expire, vote to reinstate three year terms in office for all directors of such district. At the first
25 election held after such vote, the term in office for any new directors to replace those whose seats
26 shall expire shall be four years, at the second election held after such vote, the term in office for any
27 new directors to replace those whose seats shall expire shall be two years. For the third election held
28 after such vote, at which time the seats of all six year term directors shall have expired, the school
29 board shall choose three of the director seats for election to a two year term and four of the director
30 seats for election to a three year term. Thereafter, the term in office for all directors shall be for three
31 years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified."; and
