1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2116, Page 9, Section 321.210, Line 9, by  
2 inserting after all of said line and section the following:

3 "590.705. 1. All uniformed law enforcement officers in this state shall wear a video camera  
4 affixed to the law enforcement officer's uniform while on duty. The video camera shall record the  
5 interaction between a law enforcement officer and a member of the public. The recording shall  
6 include both audio and video.

7 2. All law enforcement agencies shall preserve any recordings made by a video camera  
8 under this section for a minimum of thirty days and shall develop any policies and procedures  
9 necessary to execute the provisions of this section.

10 3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to detectives or other law enforcement  
11 officers while they are working in an undercover capacity, or to any law enforcement officer in any  
12 situation where the wearing of such a video camera would endanger the safety of the officer or the  
13 public."; and

15 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
16 accordingly.
