### AN ACT

To repeal sections 170.049 and 171.051, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to school holidays.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Sections 170.049 and 171.051, RSMo, are repealed and two new sections  
2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 170.049 and 171.051, to read as follows:

170.049. The board of each school district shall require each school in such district to  
2 devote a period of time equal to one class period to an observance that conveys the meaning and  
3 significance of Veterans Day. Such observance shall take place [on or] as close as possible to  
4 Veterans Day. The board, in consultation with the administrators of each school in the district,  
5 shall determine the activities which will constitute the required observance.

171.051. School holidays include **Veterans Day**, Thanksgiving Day, December  
2 twenty-fifth, the third Monday in February, and July fourth.
