

HB 1110 -- MEMORIAL BRIDGE DESIGNATION

SPONSOR: Rowland

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Committee on Transportation by a vote of 13 to 0.

This bill designates the bridge on U.S. Highway 160 over Lick Creek in Ozark County as the "Barney Douglas (The Citizen) Memorial Bridge." The costs for the designation are to be paid by private donation.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that Barney Douglas was a good person who was involved with the Masonic Lodge. He also volunteered with the school board.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Rowland.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
