

HB 1413 -- CAMPGROUNDS

SPONSOR: Fitzwater

This bill authorizes a campground owner to remove or cause to be removed any person who is not a registered guest or visitor of the campground; remains on the campground beyond an agreed-upon departure time and date; defaults in the payment of lawfully imposed registration, visitor fees or charges; creates a disturbance that denies other people their right to quiet enjoyment of the campground; or violates any federal, state, or local law. A person who remains on the campground after having been asked to leave by a campground owner is guilty of trespass and may be removed by the campground owner or a law enforcement officer. A person removed from a campground is entitled to a refund of the unused portion of any prepaid fees, less any amount owed to the owner or deducted for damages. The unused portion of prepaid fees may be prorated at a rate that is based upon the daily rate charged by the campground owner.
