HB 1839 -- PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR FOR MOTORCYCLE USE

SPONSOR: Spencer

Currently, every person operating or riding as a passenger on any motorcycle or motortricycle upon a state highway must wear protective headgear at all times the vehicle is in motion. This bill requires this provision to only apply to individuals who are under 18 years of age. The bill recommends that every person 18 years old or older operating or riding as a passenger on a motorcycle or motortricycle upon a state highway wear protective headgear and eyegear at all times the vehicle is in motion.
