

HB 1850 -- HISTORIC HIGHWAY DESIGNATION

SPONSOR: Hodges

This bill designates El Camino Real, a road built by Spain in the 1790's that extended from St. Louis to New Madrid, as a historic highway. The Department of Transportation must develop a logo marker and place the marker and informational signs along the portion of El Camino Real located on state road and United States highways within the state. The department must provide the logo marker and informational signs to counties and municipalities, at their request, for placement along the original El Camino Real that is not on a state road or United States highway.
