HB 1896 -- INJURING A FIRST RESPONDER

SPONSOR: Hough

This bill specifies that a person commits the crime of injuring a first responder, a class C felony, if he or she intentionally, knowingly, or purposely is engaged in the illegal manufacture of methamphetamine and:

- (1) A fire or explosion on the property results from the illegal manufacture of methamphetamine; and
- (2) A first responder arriving to the property or working at the scene is injured due to the fire or explosion.
