

HB 1928 -- COMMUNICATION INFRASTRUCTURE REMOVAL OR RELOCATION

SPONSOR: Ross

This bill prohibits political subdivisions from requiring the removal or relocation of infrastructure owned by specified communication service providers when the infrastructure is on private land, public right-of-ways, or utility property, unless the political subdivision pays the reasonable costs for the removal or relocation.

The bill will not apply when the political subdivision determines the infrastructure is in a state of disrepair and removal or relocation is necessary to preserve health and safety or if the communication service provider and the political subdivision have a franchise agreement governing removal and relocation practices.
