

HB 1943 -- CELEBRATION OF FEDERAL HOLIDAYS

SPONSOR: Webber

Currently, no state or local government entity, public building, public park, public school, or public setting or place may ban or restrict the practice, mention, celebration, or discussion of any federal holiday. This bill specifies that this provision cannot be construed to limit the authority to impose and enforce reasonable regulations related to the celebration of any federal holiday in order to protect the health and safety of the public.
