

HB 1944 -- TRAFFIC REGULATIONS FOR CERTAIN TRUCKS

Currently, the operator of certain trucks driving in the far left lane of certain interstate highways in the counties of Jefferson and St. Charles is guilty of an infraction unless the violation causes an immediate threat of an accident, in which case the violation must be deemed a class C misdemeanor, or unless an accident results from the violation, in which case the violation is a class A misdemeanor. This bill revises the provision to specify that a violation is an infraction unless an accident results from the violation, in which case it is a class C misdemeanor.
