HB 2092 -- Public Utility Eminent Domain Power

SPONSOR: Neely

This bill prohibits public utilities from exercising eminent domain to construct a certain type of electric transmission line that originates and terminates in states other than Missouri, crosses six or more counties in Missouri, converts electrical power to common voltages equal to or greater than 345,000 volts, and is constructed using steel monopole or lattice structures equal to or greater than 90 feet in height. Rural electrical cooperatives are not subject to this restriction on eminent domain.
