

HB 2132 -- HUMAN RIGHTS ACT

SPONSOR: Jones (50)

Currently, if after 180 days from the filing of a complaint alleging an unlawful discriminatory practice or a violation relating to employment or public accommodations under the Human Rights Act the Missouri Commission on Human Rights has not completed its administrative processing and the aggrieved person requests in writing, the commission must issue to the person claiming to be aggrieved a letter indicating his or her right to bring a civil action. This bill changes that time period to after 120 days.
