

HB 2146 -- NONRESIDENT PHARMACY LICENSES

This bill changes the law regarding the nonresident pharmacy licenses. The Board of Pharmacy must not renew a nonresident pharmacy license if the applicant does not hold a current pharmacy license or its equivalent in the state in which the nonresident pharmacy is located. The bill prohibits the Board of Pharmacy from renewing an out-of-state wholesale drug distributor, out-of-state pharmacy distributor, or drug distributor license or registration if the applicant does not hold a current distributor license or its equivalent in the state or jurisdiction in which the distribution facility is located; or if the applicant is a drug distributor registrant, the entity is not authorized and in good standing to operate as a drug manufacturer with the Food and Drug Administration or within the state or jurisdiction where the facility is located.
