HB 2174 -- ENFORCEMENT OF FEDERAL EXECUTIVE ACTIONS

SPONSOR: Gatschenberger

This bill specifies that no federal executive action issued by the President of the United States Congress that is not specifically appropriated by the United States Congress can compel the State of Missouri to expend any of its own funds or commandeer any of its own employees or designees to enforce the executive action.

Any existing or proposed federal executive action that infringes upon the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution or the right to bear arms under the Missouri Constitution must have no force and effect and no funds can be appropriated by the state and no employees or designees of this state can be required or permitted to promulgate or enforce the executive action.
