

HB 2279 -- BICYCLE OPERATION ON STATE ROADWAYS

SPONSOR: Korman

This bill prohibits bicycle operation on state roadways when there is a state bicycle path or trail running generally parallel and within two miles of a roadway. A bicycle may operate on the shoulder of the road if:

- (1) The bicycle is operated with a motorized escort;
- (2) The bicycle is operated as a means to ride to and from the operator's home to another residence, a place of business, a school, or a public facility; or
- (3) The person operating the bicycle is doing so due to an economic hardship.
