

HJR 61 -- RIGHT TO BEAR ARMS

Upon voter approval, this proposed constitutional amendment specifies that the right of every citizen to possess, purchase, reload, or manufacture ammunition and any other parts or articles essential to the proper functioning of arms must not be infringed nor the amounts limited and that no state tax or charge in excess of that imposed by law on retail sales of tangible personal property nor federal tax or charge can be imposed on the purchase, possession, or manufacture of the ammunition or parts. The bill requires the state to uphold these rights and under no circumstances decline to protect against their infringement.
