SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 1

Offered by Sifft of 1

Amend SCS/House Bill No. 152, Page 1, Section Title, Line 3,

2 by striking "sexual trafficking of a child" and inserting in lieu
3 thereof the following: "human trafficking"; and

4 Further amend said bill, page 4, section 566.213, line 25,
5 by inserting immediately after said line the following:

6 "589.660. As used in sections 589.660 to 589.681, the
7 following terms mean:

8 (1) "Address", a residential street address, school
9 address, or work address of a person, as specified on the
10 person's application to be a program participant;

11 (2) "Application assistant", an employee of a state or
12 local agency, or of a nonprofit program that provides counseling,
13 referral, shelter, or other specialized service to victims of
14 domestic violence, rape, sexual assault, human trafficking, or
15 stalking, who has been designated by the respective agency or
16 program, and who has been trained and registered by the secretary
17 of state to assist individuals in the completion of program
18 participation applications;

19 (3) "Designated address", the address assigned to a program
20 participant by the secretary;

21 (4) "Mailing address", an address that is recognized for
22 delivery by the United States Postal Service;

1 (5) "Program", the address confidentiality program
2 established in section 589.663;

3 (6) "Program participant", a person certified by the
4 secretary of state as eligible to participate in the address
5 confidentiality program;

6 (7) "Secretary", the secretary of state.

7 589.663. There is created in the office of the secretary of
8 state a program to be known as the "Address Confidentiality
9 Program" to protect victims of domestic violence, rape, sexual
10 assault, human trafficking, or stalking by authorizing the use of
11 designated addresses for such victims and their minor children.
12 The program shall be administered by the secretary under the
13 following application and certification procedures:

14 (1) An adult person, a parent or guardian acting on behalf
15 of a minor, or a guardian acting on behalf of an incapacitated
16 person may apply to the secretary to have a designated address
17 assigned by the secretary to serve as the person's address or the
18 address of the minor or incapacitated person;

19 (2) The secretary may approve an application only if it is
20 filed with the office of the secretary in the manner established
21 by rule and on a form prescribed by the secretary. A completed
22 application shall contain:

23 (a) The application preparation date, the applicant's
24 signature, and the signature and registration number of the
25 application assistant who assisted the applicant in applying to
26 be a program participant;

27 (b) A designation of the secretary as agent for purposes of
28 service of process and for receipt of first-class mail, legal
29 documents, and certified mail;

1 (c) A sworn statement by the applicant that the applicant
2 has good reason to believe that he or she:

3 a. Is a victim of domestic violence, rape, sexual assault,
4 human trafficking, or stalking; and

5 b. Fears further violent acts from his or her assailant;

6 (d) The mailing address where the applicant may be
7 contacted by the secretary or a designee and the telephone number
8 or numbers where the applicant may be called by the secretary or
9 the secretary's designee; and

10 (e) One or more addresses that the applicant requests not
11 be disclosed for the reason that disclosure will jeopardize the
12 applicant's safety or increase the risk of violence to the
13 applicant or members of the applicant's household;

14 (3) Upon receipt of a properly completed application, the
15 secretary may certify the applicant as a program participant. A
16 program participant is certified for four years following the
17 date of initial certification unless the certification is
18 withdrawn or cancelled before that date. The secretary shall
19 send notification of lapsing certification and a reapplication
20 form to a program participant at least four weeks prior to the
21 expiration of the program participant's certification;

22 (4) The secretary shall forward first class mail, legal
23 documents, and certified mail to the appropriate program
24 participants."; and

25 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.

10 407.020."; and

11 Further amend said bill, page 3, section 566.212, line 16,
12 by inserting immediately at the end of said line the following:

13 "In addition to any other penalties provided under this section,
14 such conduct shall constitute an unlawful practice under section
15 407.020."; and

16 Further amend said bill, page 4, section 566.213, line 15,
17 by inserting immediately at the end of said line the following:

18 "In addition to any other penalties provided under this section,
19 such conduct shall constitute an unlawful practice under section
20 407.020.".
