1 AMEND House Bill No. 676, Page 1, in the Title, Lines 2 and 3, by deleting the words "the  
2 education innovation investment act"; and inserting in lieu thereof the words "education innovation";  
3 and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 135.1680, Line 74, by inserting immediately after all of said  
6 line and section the following:

8 "167.045. 1. Except as provided in subsection 4 of this section, a public school that  
9 participates in an activity sponsored by the Missouri State High School Activities Association  
10 (MSHSAA) shall provide a student that attends a home school, as defined in section 167.031, who  
11 resides in the public school's attendance area with the opportunity to participate in the activity on  
12 behalf of the public school in the same manner that the public school provides the opportunity to  
13 participate to students enrolled in the public school.

14 2. A home school student who seeks to participate or who participates in a MSHSAA  
15 activity on behalf of a public school is subject to the relevant policies that apply to students enrolled  
16 in the public school, including policies regarding registration, age eligibility, fees, insurance,  
17 transportation, physical condition, qualifications, responsibilities, event schedules, standards of  
18 behavior, and performance.

19 3. As a condition of participation by a home school student in a MSHSAA activity under this  
20 section, the individual who primarily provides instruction to the student shall submit a written  
21 verification to the public school indicating whether the student is:

22 (1) Receiving a passing grade in each course or subject taught; and

23 (2) Maintaining satisfactory progress towards academic advancement or promotion.

24 4. A home school student is not authorized by this section to participate in a MSHSAA  
25 activity during the remainder of any school year during which the student was previously enrolled in  
26 a public school.

27 5. The MSHSAA may not prohibit a home school student from participating in activities in  
28 the manner authorized by this section."; and

30 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
31 accordingly.
