10 "2. Prior to enrolling in any state course access program  
11 course, a student shall first receive approval from his or her  
12 guidance counselor. Guidance counselors shall approve or  
13 disapprove a student's request to enroll based on the counselor's  
14 assessment of whether participation in the program and enrollment  
15 in a particular course is in the student's best interest. The  
16 department shall develop a procedure under which a student may  
17 appeal the decision of a guidance counselor made under the  
18 provisions of this section."; and

21 by deleting "2." and inserting in lieu thereof "3."; and

23 Further amend said bill, Page 2, Section 161.1022, Line 15,  
24 by deleting "3." and inserting in lieu thereof "4."; and

26 Further amend said bill, Page 2, Section 161.1022, Line 20,  
27 by deleting "4." and inserting in lieu thereof "5."; and
