HB 1062 -- PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

SPONSOR: Webber

This bill requires employers to grant a parent, guardian, or custodian of a child to leave work for four hours per school year, at increments of at least one hour, to attend parent-teacher conferences. The time must be mutually agreed upon by employer and employee.

An employer may require an employee to provide a written request for the leave at least five school days before the leave is taken; and an employee to provide documentation that during the time of the leave, the employee attended a parent-teacher conference.

An employer is not required to pay an employee for any leave taken under these provisions.

A parent, guardian, or custodian must be granted leave in accordance with these provisions for each child of the parent, quardian, or custodian who is enrolled in school.
