HB 1282 -- PRODUCTS SOLD IN THE MISSOURI STATE CAPITOL BUILDING

SPONSOR: Taylor

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Committee on Emerging Issues by a vote of 10 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Select Committee on General Laws by a vote of 6 to 1.

This bill requires any non-food product sold in the Missouri State Capitol Building to be made in the United States.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill sets a good example for public officials. The state has authority to direct its own expenditures and practices in a manner beneficial to the general public.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Taylor.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
