SB 110 -- University of Missouri Board of Curators

SPONSOR: Schaefer

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Emerging Issues by a vote of 6 to 3.

This bill prohibits any member of the University of Missouri Board of Curators from voting to appoint to hire, or employ in any way in any position in the university any person who appointed him or her to the board. Any such vote taken by a curator will be null and void. Any curator who violates this prohibition will immediately forfeit his or her curator position.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill will prohibit conflicts of interest and ensure integrity of the selection process for the University of Missouri Board of Curators.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Schaefer.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
