SCS SB 435 -- CONVEYANCE IN ST. LOUIS COUNTY

SPONSOR: Walsh (Pierson)

COMMITTEE ACTIONS: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Corrections by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Select Committee on Judiciary by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill allows the Governor to convey the state's interest in specified property owned by the state in St. Louis County to the county. The instrument of conveyance must include a statement recognizing the special relationship between the state and St. Louis County with regard to the use of the property and specifying that the state and county must continue to cooperate regarding the use of the property.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill conveys two acres in Bellefontaine Neighbors to St. Louis County Parks.

Testifying for the bill was Senator Walsh.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
